

AML EY 2001 OVERSIGHT WORK PLAN
Relating to the
ILLINOIS AMLRD STAFF TRAINING COURSE

OBJECTIVE: To provide participants information about the AML reclamation process from initial problem identification through successful reclamation in a one day training course. The purpose of this effort is to increase participants' knowledge and understanding of the principles and requirements of AML Reclamation Programs operating under the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 and its implementing regulations.

IFO TASKS:

- C To prepare a course of instruction acceptable to the Illinois AMLRD management designed to achieve the stated objective, and meet the specific needs of the Illinois AML Program. Course material will be developed by the IFO in recognition of the fact that this will be a refresher course for some participants, and a first-time course for others.

- C To provide qualified, knowledgeable instructors, and present the approved training course to Illinois AMLRD staff, and others at the AMLRD's discretion, at a time and place suitable to the AMLRD and IFO.

STATE TASKS:

- C To provide necessary information, guidance, and assistance to the IFO in developing and conducting the AML training course.

- C To provide adequate physical facilities in which to hold the training course.

- C To participate in the training program.

OUTPUT MEASURES:

An enhanced understanding and increased knowledge of successful AML Program operations in accordance with the approved Illinois State AML Reclamation Plan and the Surface Coal Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 as amended.
